Climate change is a risk multiplier. It is intensifying and increasing the number, and severity, of humanitarian crises across the world, and reversing important economic and social development gains. The world's poorest and most vulnerable, who are least responsible for causing climate change, continue to bear the brunt of its impacts. This is an extreme global injustice.

The UN climate talks in Marrakech, COP22, are an opportunity to implement the promises made in Paris. Governments must demonstrate that they are willing to take serious action on climate change and to accelerate the positive examples of action. COP22 must ensure adequate support for poorer countries and communities that are already experiencing the worst impacts of climate change

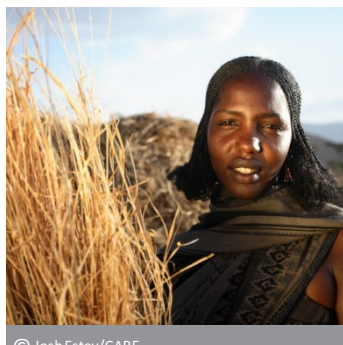
CARE demands that governments at UN climate conference, COP22:

1 Take concrete steps to put the 1.5°C limit into practice, build it into regular stocktakes and promote pro-poor renewable energies.

2 Scale-up finance for gender-equitable adaptation, operationalize the global adaptation goal to assist the poor.
